Sub:- Grant of conditional permission to the **Prasanna College of Ayurved College and Hospital, Laila Belthangady, Karnataka** with **100 seats** in UG (BAMS) course under Section 13A of the IMCC ACT, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's order No.R.12011/29/2015-EP (IM-1) for 2016-17 dated 09.11.2016 related to admission matter for the year 2016-17 intimating to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2nd professional for consideration of the case for the 2017-18 sessions.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 19-20.04.2017 and to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to this Ministry.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 & relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC) for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017 (available at Ministry's website <www.ayush.gov.in>), it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:

- (i) Teachers: 100% eligible teachers, 12 Higher Faculties (Professor/Reader) in 06 Departments, at least 1P/R + 1L in each of 06 Departments & 1L of Sanskrit in the college for 2nd professional for 61-100 UG seats and any 05 part time teachers as per relaxed criteria against the requirement of 10 as per RMS, 2016;

- (ii) Beds in hospital: 100 beds in hospital for 61-100 UG intake capacity;
- (iii) 200 patients per day in OPD during the year 2016 for 61-100 UG intake capacity;
- (iv) Minimum 40% bed occupancy in IPD for UG College during the year 2016;
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 75% of required equipment as specified under the schedule VII of MSR/as per the Policy dated 12.06.2017; and
- (vi) Other requirements: as specified in Sub-regulation (1)(b) of regulation 10 of the RMS/as per policy dated 12.06.2017.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant of conditional permission** to the **Prasanna College of Ayurved College and Hospital, Laila Belthangady, Karnataka** with **100 seats** in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19:

- i. all the relevant provisions of the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 & 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- ii. relevant requirements under the (Minimum Standard of Education in Indian Medicine) amendment Regulations of 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- iii. all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2018-19.
